Archie sent the following message to me today and asked me to send it out.

*Archie reports that 7 new Homeowner's name signs are being installed during the first week of May to replace the most faded and weathered ones. Those being replaced are Stone, Dillard, Rodgers, Lange, Hanson, Kristin, and Lowe.*

*Last week directional signs for Mary's Path and Pueblo Ruins Rd. were replacced. The new signs have larger name identification and larger street numbers and all signs are done in reflective red. Additional signs will be done as required due to weathering and fading.*

*Also the road edges got an additional weed spot-spraying last week as well as our frontage along the rock wall on Road 23.*

*Due to Richard Blake's comment about growing grass on road edges, Archie is investigating all options of grass varieties that will do the job and will 'drill' in the grass seed this Fall in selected areas. Suggestions are appreciated and none will be ignored--maybe forgotten--but not ignored.*

*The cattle have been hard on all the 'dry stacked' rock walls and on the entrances. Archie's crew will maintain and repair any damage along our road frontage, including any owner's entrance rock walls. This will be done on a weekly basis.*

*The roads are in excellent condition and Archie has arranged for continuous maintenance as needed to insure that we have the best maintained roads in the County.*
